With student learning as the primary guiding focus, the Secondary Comprehensive Counselor will ensure students are supported to access the curriculum and develop the skills and attitudes that are necessary to be successful at school.

The counselor will be sensitive and knowledgeable about the needs that arise in an international school setting and will work closely with the school's leadership, advisors, subject teachers, parents and the Student Support Services/University Advising Teams to support them with strategies that meet each student's needs.

A desire to work as part of a diverse, multilingual community is important for this role. A background in both social/emotional and university counselling is preferred and a desire to be part of an IB school is necessary.
